

DIRECTOR'S NOTE


Switzerland, Germany, Finland, and Italy are among the leaders in Europe in terms of child-lessness, with almost one in six couples in Switzerland remaining involuntarily childless, and the trend is rising. Such an unfulfilled desire can have far-reaching consequences. Particularly if those affected decide to pursue surrogacy, which is very expensive and prohibited in many places. Choosing this path impacts not only the intended parents but also the surrogate mothers, who often act out of economic necessity.

OUR CHILD deals with surrogacy tourism in emerging countries and the associated ethical problems in the context of social inequality. The film tells a universal story about the profound human longing for family happiness in a globalized world.

The adventurous shoot in the vibrant capital of Georgia, Tbilisi, was an unforgettable experience; the collaboration with a community of talented filmmakers and artists from Georgia, Ukraine, and Switzerland, a great privilege.

Due to the fine line between fiction and reality, the film chooses a restrained visual language that deliberately and whenever possible refrains from aestheticizations. It was my earnest concern to meet our story's claim to social and emotional authenticity.

I was inspired by filmmakers like Andrea Arnold and Eliza Hittman, whose work served as a creative compass for me and cinematographer Gabriela Betschart.



PRODUCER'S NOTE

Surrogacy is illegal in many Western countries. Where it is legal, as in the United States, it is very expensive and unaffordable for most people. In other countries, such as Georgia, the commercial surrogacy business focuses on low-income women who need the money to fulfill their own dreams or support their families.

OUR CHILD shows the complex power dynamics and the relationship between intended parents and surrogate mothers. Although the intended parents have the financial power, the surrogate mother has the biological and ultimately decisive power to fulfill their heart's desire for a child.

Samuel Flückiger has created a sensitive and emotional drama that sheds light on both perspectives and raises moral and ethical questions without categorically condemning either side. This openness is intended to encourage the audience to reflect.

Furthermore, the film addresses social taboos surrounding the issue of unwanted childlessness in a multi-layered way. Infertility is a highly emotional topic, and those affected often remain silent about their fate out of shame. We want to encourage society as a whole to work together to find solutions and break these taboos. Last but not least, the film highlights the need to ensure fair access to fertility treatments for all while explaining the risks of commercialization.

As a producer, I am particularly proud that, after ALA KACHUU, which was nominated for an Oscar© in 2022, we are once again competing for this prestigious award with the short film OUR CHILD, and thus have another chance to position a socially relevant topic on an international stage.

Born in 1982, Samuel Flückiger grew up in Basel, Switzerland. After graduating in Sociology and Cinema Studies from the University of Zurich, he attended professional programs in producing and screenwriting at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) School of Theatre, Film, and Television.

Samuel Flückiger's award-winning short films TERMINAL (2013), NIGHTLIGHT (2015), 40 METERS (2018), and WINDOWLESS (2019) screened at various renowned festivals around the world and were sold to multiple broadcasters, including CBC (Canada) and SRF (Switzerland).


